## The Cruise America Child Seat Set Up



Pictures are from a C25 dinette seat, but the same on compact and large RV layout-with backrest removed showing lap belts and tethers. Depending on the size of the child, it may be necessary to fix the dinette in the lower position, i.e., bed, while traveling. For example: sometimes, the child might be too big for his legs to fit comfortably under the table; therefore, it can be an idea to lower the table.



Car seat should have something similar to the above fasteners. Thin buckle to attach to tether. Thicker fasteners will not attach.

## How to Set Up a Child Seat



LOWER DINETTE AND PLACE CHILD SEAT ON DINETTE BENCH FACING FORWARD



WHEN CHILD SEAT IS BEING INSTALLED. TETHER AND LAPBELT ATTACHED (BUT NOT CINCHED)



TOP TETHER ATTACHED TO LOWER TETHER



RUN LAP BELT THROUGH BACK OF CAR SEAT AND SECURE. TIGHTEN AS NEEDED.
